Overview:

The SNASH application requires the use of a properly formatted XML configuration file, which may be provided to you or created yourself. Upon selecting the XML file, you will be prompted to enter metadata based on the file, and a location to save the audio to.

There are a few rules for the data entry. If they are not met, the "start recording" button will not function, and a warning message will be displayed. Simply fix the problems listed in this message and try again, and the recording will begin.

Data Entry Rules:

- The file location must be selected, and in a writable directory.
- Data fields may not be left blank.
- Data fields may not be more than 50 characters in length.
- Data fields' values must be made of letters, numbers, and accepted characters (ASCII 32-126).
